- the safeguarding and protection of children, young people and all vulnerable adults.

It is the responsibility of each one of us to prevent physical, sexual or emotional abuse of children and young people and to respond quickly when this occurs.

Managing Trustees are required to ensure that those who use their premises under licence or who hire the premises for regular or occasional use are given a copy of the local church safeguarding policy and declare their willingness to comply with the safeguarding policy of the Methodist Church or comparable equivalent guidelines and procedures (such as Scouting and Guiding national safeguarding policy).
