OUR CALLING: CIRCUIT POLICY

The Circuit Mission Statement:

"To have a living relationship with God through worship, to encourage one another to grow as Christians, to live the Good News of Jesus and to share God's unconditional love for everyone"

In a Covid-19 world, looking towards what it means to be the Ceredigion Circuit in a post-Covid context, this document is the Circuit Mission Policy agreed by the Circuit Meeting on 16 September 2020.

The calling of the Methodist Church is to respond to the gospel of God's love in Christ and to live out its discipleship in worship and mission.

Drawing from our Methodist tradition, enriched by other parts of the wider Church, the Circuit seeks to shape its common life around the *Our Calling Statement of the Methodist Church*. During the coming year we are framing this around *A Methodist Way of Life* launched at the on-line Methodist Conference of 2020 (see Appendix 2). The Ceredigion Circuit is committed to being an inclusive and safe place for all people and therefore undertakes all its work and activity in accordance with the Methodist Church's Safeguarding Policy and Equality, Diversity & Inclusion policies.

Worship: The Church exists to increase awareness of God's presence and celebrate God's love

Methodist Way of Life: As far as we are able, with God's help:

- We will pray daily.
- We will worship with others regularly.
- We will look and listen for God in Scripture, and the world.

The Ceredigion Circuit will seek to fulfil this by:

- 1. Providing worship opportunities for people of all ages through
 - a. gathered events
 - b. online
 - c. CD
 - d. Worship Packs
- 2. Training, resourcing & equipping Local Preachers and Worship Leaders
- 3. Providing teaching & resources for
 - a. personal prayer
 - b. exploration of scripture and theology in a local and world context

Learning and Caring: The Church exists to help people to grow and learn as Christians, through mutual support and care.

The Methodist Way of Life: as far as we are able, with God's help:

- We will care for ourselves and those around us,
- We will learn more about our faith,
- We will practice hospitality and generosity.

The Ceredigion Circuit will seek to fulfil this by:

1. Providing pastoral care and support for members and the community roll

- 2. Training and supporting pastoral visitors
- 3. Providing opportunities for people to learn about the Christian faith and develop their life of discipleship within the world

Service: The Church exists to be a good neighbour to people in need and to challenge injustice

A Methodist Way of Life: As far as we are able, with God's help:

- We will help people in our communities and beyond.
- We will care for creation and all God's gifts.
- We will challenge injustice.

The Ceredigion Circuit will seek to fulfil this by:

- 1. Affirming and praying for its members as they seek to live out their discipleship whether at home, work, college or school and within the community
- 2. Drawing on the resources of the Joint Public Issues Team to inform, educate, resource and encourage one another to engage as Christian people in the local community and wider world
- 3. Using Fairtrade and environmentally friendly products in our buildings and at events organised by the circuit and the churches
- 4. Ensuring our buildings are safe and accessible places for all people and available for other groups to use

Evangelism: The Church exists to make more followers of Jesus

A Methodist Way of Life: as far as we are able, with God's help:

- We will speak of the love of God.
- We will live in a way that draws others to Jesus.
- We will share our faith with others.

The Ceredigion Circuit will seek to fulfil this by:

- 1. Providing opportunities to learn about mission and evangelism and grow in confidence in sharing faith
- 2. Encouraging one another to speak of our experience of God
- 3. Identifying and responding to mission opportunities within our communities
- 4. Learning about, supporting, and where possible, sharing in mission in other places

- When was the last time you were able to talk about God?
- What opportunities to share your faith have there been since we last met?
- How have you responded to opportunities to share your faith?
- Is there anyone you might invite to consider Christian faith?
